A detailed rehearsal schedule will be distributed at the conclusion of the audition. Cast members scheduled for the full 4½ hours of rehearsal will be asked to bring a sack lunch, dinner or snack.

The performances will be held on Friday, July 22nd at 6:30pm and will be presented at the Movie Reel BLDG 1845. The students in the cast will be called for dress rehearsal before the performance that day at 2:30pm. All those cast must be available for all scheduled performances.
